<u>Official Itinerary:</u>

DAY 1) Monday, December 16th

- J, K, R, G2, & C will leave St. Louis ~6am
- Pick up G1 & M from Columbia ~7:30am
- Pick up E from Kansas City ~10am
- Lunch in Salina, Kansas ~12:45pm
- Can get dinner along the way or wait until Denver
- Arrive in Denver ~8pm
- Open-ended time after ~8pm
- Go to bed early:)
- Spending the night at a hotel in Denver

DAY 2) Tuesday, December 17th

- Wake up ~7am for a Red Rocks sunrise?
- Breakfast at Country Road Cafe
- Ice skating on Evergreen Lake
- Lunch at Beau Jo's
- Open-ended time all afternoon
- Check-in for AirBNB is after 3pm
- Dinner in Denver
- Spending the night at an <u>AirBNB</u> near Evergreen



DAY 3) Wednesday, December 18th

- Check-out of AirBNB is @10am
- Breakfast ~10am at Lakeshore, Diner 285, Bagelry, or Safeway
- Scenic drive up Squaw Pass
- Pack a lunch for snowshoeing
- Snowshoe Chief Mountain ~11am-3pm
- Snowshoe Echo Lake ~3pm-4pm (optional)
- Open-ended time 4–6pm
- Dinner at Mac Nation 6pm
- Leave for Frisco ~7-7:30pm
- Arrive in Frisco ~8-8:30pm
- Spending the night at an AirBNB near Frisco

DAY 4) Thursday, December 19th

- Check-out of AirBNB is @10am
- Breakfast at Butterhorn Bakery
- Tubing in Frisco opens @10am
- Lunch; somewhere cheap
- Open-ended time all afternoon
- Leave for Glenwood Springs ~8:30pm
- Arrive in Glenwood Spgs ~10pm (unless check-in is earlier)
- Spending the night at a **hotel** in Glenwood Spgs

DAY 5) Friday, December 20th

- There are 3 hot springs attractions in Glenwood; avg. price is \$25
 - Iron Mtn. Hot Springs is my personal favorite!
- Glenwood Springs Adventure Park is incredible, but probably expensive. I'll need to call them and see if they offer group rates if we're interested
- Frontier Historical Museum
- Red Mountain is a really pretty hike, we might need to snowshoe it though
- Hanging Lake is also a gorgeous hike, but it requires a \$10/person permit
- We could literally just drive around, explore, do some window shopping, take pictures, find random places to go sledding, etc.

- Spending the night in the same **hotel** as Thursday
